Waste-Paper



Residual waste such as:

- sweepings
- · vacuum cleaner bags
- nappies
- · cigarette ends
- · coal ash, wood ash
- · sanitary towels, tampons
- · cotton buds, cotton wool
- · wallpaper remains
- · carpet remains
- leather
- rubber
- light bulbs
- scraps of cloth / textiles
- · candle wax waste
- · torn / broken ladies' tights
- plaster, dressing material
- · old ink pads
- · old ball-point pens
- · razor blades
- · bicvcle tyres
- · toothbrushes
- · disposable lighters
- · photos, slides
- · coat hangers
- · children's toys
- plastic piping
- plastic folders
- file folders
- cat litter
- dried paint remains
- · dirty Styrofoam
- · video cassettes

Kitchen waste such as:

- fruit and vegetable waste
- · coffee grounds, tea leaves, coffee filter papers and tea
- · eggshells
- absorbent paper such as filter papers, paper towels made of pulp, such as tissues, kitchen paper, serviettes, dirty newspapers
- · egg cartons and fruit baskets made of paper-mâché / groundwood pulp
- · crumpled paper
- small amounts of leftover cooked food
- rotten or mouldy food remains
- bones
- · hair, feathers
- wood shavings (only from non-treated wood)
- houseplants

Garden waste such as:

- hedge cuttings
- shrub cuttings
- · grass cuttings
- leaves
- · other vegetable garden waste

Retail packaging such as:

plastic containers such

shampoo bottles, washing-up liquid bottles. pots of dairy products polystyrene tray packaging from fruit, vegetables, meat

- plastic foil / film
- · composite materials such

milk and juice cartons soup packets coffee packaging confectionary packaging


- · aluminium such as: tubes yoghurt pot lids chocolate foil packaging
- tins / cans such as: drink cans tinned food cans empty aerosol spray cans bottle tops

Street collection and paper bin

· waste-paper, cardboard, cardboard boxes such as:

newspapers magazines catalogues brochures writing paper and exercise books printed matter envelopes flour and sugar bags corrugated cardboard boxes grey and white boxes washing powder boxes

Collection Container



- · glass waste white glass brown glass green glass (other coloured glass bottles should be disposed of in the green glass container)
- tins / cans such as: drink cans tinned food cans empty aerosol spray cans bottle tops

Residual waste and organic waste bins, yellow bags and old paper should only be put out shortly before emptying/collection, no later than 6.00 a.m. on the collection day.
